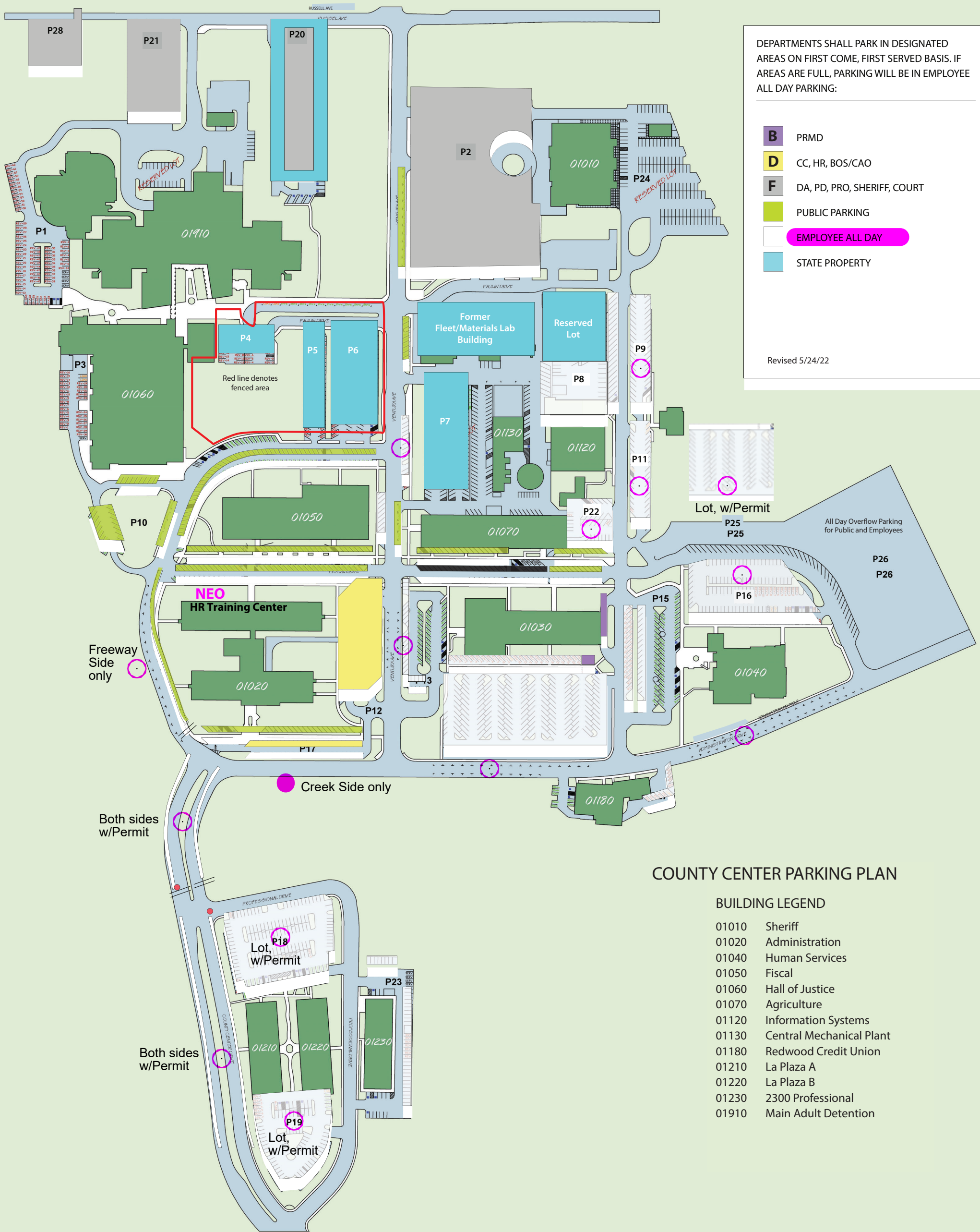

New Employee Parking Instructions:

- Congratulations! As of the date and time of your New Employee Orientation (NEO), you are a County of Sonoma employee!
- Please ensure that you do not park in the time-limited spaces that are intended for members of the public or in reserved parking spaces that require a parking permit. Also, depending upon your regular work location and its parking requirements, you may be issued a parking pass in the near future.
- The County Complex parking map is available on the County website: [County Complex Parking Map \(ca.gov\)](#) and detailed maps are attached below. When parking, please be sure to check the posted signage because permitted/restricted areas are subject to change.
- Plan on arriving 15-30 minutes prior to the start of NEO to find parking.

For County employees with parking permits:

- Park in lot appropriate for your permit.
- Permit must be clearly visible through the windshield from outside your vehicle.
- Do not park in time-limited or reserved parking spaces.
- If you have lost your issued employee permit, contact Sonoma Public Infrastructure (SPI) at 707-565-2550 or SPI-Parking@sonoma-county.org. SPI is open Monday – Friday, 8am – 5pm.
